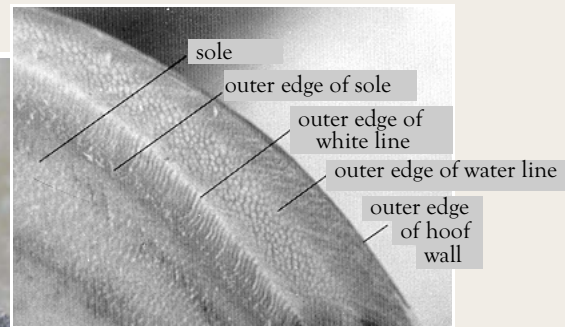


## Step 1



### Grid volar dome for mustang roll

[Rules of Rasping #13, Step 8a, Bulletin #106]

*(Above)* The mustang roll should be commenced outside the water line. This will leave a narrow rim of horn—about one-eighth to one-quarter of an inch wide—outside the white line for active wear [See Bulletin #107]. I've identified the outside perimeter of this rim with a permanent marker. This is Step 8a in the R/R, so note that the natural thickness of the hoof wall has already been established.

*(Right, facing page)* These views of a white wild horse hoof reveal the natural turn of the roll, including the rim of hard horn at the water line (blue arrows). This is your ultimate goal in executing the correct mustang roll.
